

Corrections and Addenda to the Fifth Edition

1. October 28, 2010—On page 76, a note has been deleted on the bioretention sketch. The corrected sketch is in the version reposted to cccleanwater.org (still dated October 20, 2010). The note addressed the slope of the underdrain.
2. February 22, 2011—On page 41, the final parenthesis in Equation 4-2 should be omitted. For an explanation of the equation, see page 17. [superseded—see #6 below]
3. February 22, 2011—On page 72, the information regarding underdrains should be supplemented by the guidance in the February 22, 2010 memo, “Design of Integrated Management Practices: Vertical Position of Underdrains in Bioretention Facilities, Review and Interim Guidance” available [here](#).
4. December 1, 2011—Refer to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board’s November 28, 2011 amendment to the Municipal Regional Permit to determine eligibility of a project to use non-LID treatment. A summary of the criteria is in the 2-page “Stormwater C.3 Update” available [here](#).
5. December 1, 2011—Refer to Attachment L in the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board’s November 28, 2011 amendment for updated soil mix specifications for bioretention facilities. The mix is the same at Appendix B in the 5th Edition; however, gradation specifications for the compost fraction have been added.
6. December 1, 2011—Consult with municipal staff, and refer to the draft updated *Guidebook* Chapter 4, to determine the feasibility of infiltration, evapotranspiration, and harvesting/reuse.
