



## Training to Become a Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD) / Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP)

The new California Construction General Permit No. 2009-009-DWQ (CGP) was recently adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) on July 1, 2010. For projects requiring a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), the new CGP requires the SWPPP to be developed and certified by a QSD. Actual in-field work must be conducted or implemented by a QSD or QSP. In order to become a QSD or QSP, you must attend a state-sponsored or approved training course by 09/02/2011\* and pass the exam, which is offered and proctored by the State and Regional Water Boards.
