- State agency that protects and manages the state's fish and wildlife. Wardens have statewide jurisdiction and their primary functioning is enforcing Fish and Game code. They investigate reports of violations, collect and preserve evidence, write reports, and testify in court.

- County CUPA that performs commercial/industrial storm water inspections & illicit discharge response under contract with County Public Works in unincorporated areas.

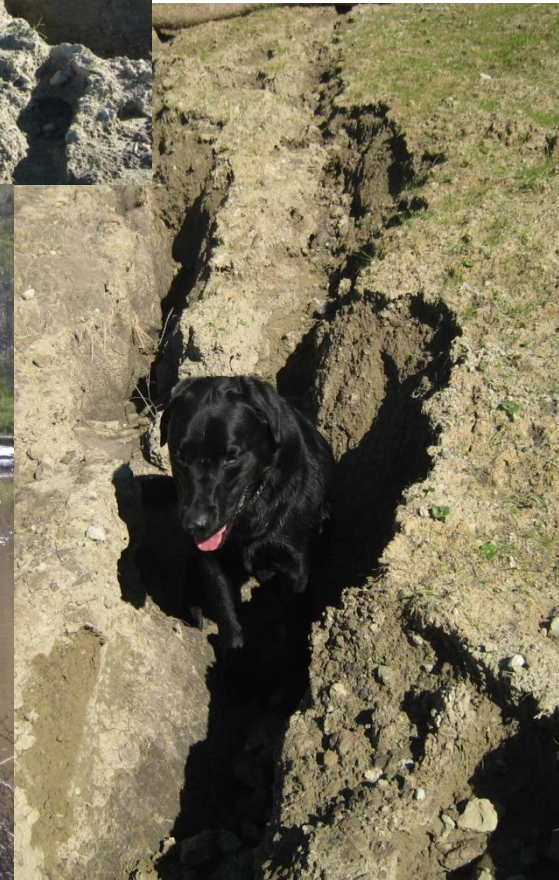
