Recycling Reduces Waste

Recycling Makes Cents

A 2016 study from the EPA (https://www.epa.gov/smm/recycling-economic-information-rei-report) found that in a single year, recycling and reuse activities in the United States accounted for 757,000 jobs, \$36.6 billion in wages, and \$6.7 billion in tax revenues. Many recycling and donations centers in Contra Costa County are open despite COVID-19, helping provide jobs and recycling opportunities to residents.

Recycling Reduces Pollution

Recycling does more than just save a few cans and create a few jobs. Recycling also helps reduce pollution and greenhouse gasses! By making the split decision to put our clean, used cans and bottles in the recycling bin, they will turn into a new product and won't end up as litter that pollutes our waterways.
